**Dear Donor,**

Your doctor is requesting one of the following types of special donation”:

1. An autologous donation – you donate your own blood for use in your surgery
2. A directed donation – family and friends may donate blood for you
3. A therapeutic donation – a physician-ordered donation for patient treatment

To help make your donation quick and efficient, please ensure you have the following documentation before you arrive for your donation appointment.

1. STBTC Physician Order; completed and signed by your doctor.  
*Please ensure your orders have been processed before making your appointment.*
2. Ask your doctor if you have any medical conditions that will require a clearance from other doctors that are providing care to you. Make sure you arrange to get the medical clearance from these doctors, and bring them with you for your donation.

4. Obtain a complete list of all medications you are currently taking.
